

POOR WEATHER PROTOCOL

If poor weather is forecast for a home fixture, it is the responsibility of the captain playing first to perform a pitch inspection as early as possible. If the pitch is frozen or for any other reason unplayable, the following actions need to be taken as soon as the decision to cancel the game has been made:

1. Contact your team and the opposition
2. Contact both umpires (or Umpire co-ordinator if umpires are not appointed)
3. Phone Sonning Clubhouse to cancel teas
4. Contact your league
5. Inform the Secretary and the Fixture Secretary that the fixture has not been fulfilled

You should agree a date and time for the re-arranged game as early as possible. In order to do so, you need to liaise with the following people:

1. Contact Fixture Secretary to check pitch availability / contact details for the opposition
2. Contact opposition to agree timings
3. Confirm re-arranged game with the Fixture Secretary to finalise pitch bookings
4. Contact your league
5. Contact Umpire co-ordinator and kindly ask if they can organise umpires
6. Phone Sonning Clubhouse to book in the teas

Please give everyone mentioned above as much notice as possible.
